Jeff Molby is a Rotarian from Michigan, pedaling his bike on a two-year mission around the country to help people get to their chemo appointments. He's ridden almost 7,000 miles and he's just getting started because there are still too many Americans who can't get to their cancer treatments.

For decades, the American Cancer Society has had a program to help with this called Road to Recovery. It works like a slow version of Uber except the drivers are volunteers, the rides are free for the patients, and the stakes are... very high. Unfortunately, it's been heartbreakingly short on drivers since the pandemic. More than HALF of all requests were rejected last year due to a shortage of drivers.


