The Boys and Girls Club of Oshkosh has been on a journey starting in 2019 with conversations with partners. After seeing a need to serve more kids and families, a capital campaign began.

Five phases make up the campaign consisting of remodeling, new construction, playground, community center and an additional gym. The Boys and Girls Club serves 150 more kids per day and has more than 20 partners serving not only their kids and families but also kids and families throughout the Oshkosh community.

For over two decades, the Oshkosh Southwest Rotary Club (the Club) has been making a significant difference in the lives of people in Peru. Most recently, the club has focused on installing and maintaining soy cows in several municipalities in the Lima metropolitan area, including Ate. These soy cows, operated by local municipalities with the club's support, provide soy milk, offering

much-needed supplemental protein to residents in lower socio-economic communities.

Additionally, the club has financed a bakery that enriches its baked goods with protein from the soy milk by-products. The club, with the generous support of the club's members and their families, has also established a dental clinic to provide much-needed care to residents.

Finally, the club has assisted the Ate municipal library in purchasing textbooks, computers, and copiers. This month, the club is honored to host Bertha Pacheco, its main contact in Peru, whose dedication has been invaluable to these ongoing efforts. It would not be an understatement to say that Rotary's work in Peru would have been impossible without her help. She works as an interpreter and is critical to arranging meetings with governmental officials and procuring supplies for maintaining the soy cows and bakery. The club extends its deepest gratitude for her unwavering service.


