Rotary International—Peru Update

and may purchase updated imaging equipment if the clinic is operational next year.

Finally, Nick spoke at the Miraflores Rotary club, which had three other clubs in attendance. He gave a speech providing background on our club's work in Peru and presented Carlos Riojas, a former member and a Rotarian, with the Paul Harris award and accompanying medal. Riojas's club has partnered with Southwest Rotary on projects in Peru and Ate, which is a suburb of Lima.

In 2001, Oshkosh Southwest Rotary began a partnership to provide nutritious food options for the people of Peru by purchasing a soy cow and an oven for a bakery. Many of the residents served by this project are internally displaced refugees due to the civil war in the 1990s between the Peruvian government and the Shining Path Maoist insurgency.

Recently, Southwest Rotarians Bill Thimke and Nick Hahn visited Peru to check in on several projects. Southwest Rotary previous purchased a copier for their underfunded library. On this trip, they purchased text books, paper and toner for the copier. They also awarded a laptop to a young man at an assembly at the library. The man was extremely grateful and confided that he was a refugee from Venezuela.

Rotary also purchased trays to use in the bakery in Huaycan, as well as cleaning supplies and protective gloves. The bakery is still operating and making bread.

The municipal dental clinic the club helped start is restarting at a different location. Hopefully, by the next time club visit, it will have the compressors and water line

installed so it can be fully operational again. Rotary purchased supplies for the clinic
